What to know about LCJ and the Schedule:

Check-in for LCJ will begin at 6:00 PM on Friday, April 23rd and dinner will be served upon arrival. The program will begin promptly at 7:00 PM. Continue for approximately 5 miles to Moss Bluff (a community north of LC, but still considered LC). Turn left on Highway 378 (Wendy's restaurant on left). Drive for approximately 2.5 miles.
