



Directions for Letter Writing Campaign to Senator Landrieu

- Handwritten is the best on normal loose leaf paper or on your personal stationary. Make sure it is written neatly. Business owners can and should use their company stationary – the letter should be typed.
 - Send all letters separately.
 - Send one letter separately from the school or group on letterhead.
 - Should be short, to the point, and polite, but not aggressive or disrespectful.
 - Along with the essential elements listed below, the letter can discuss:
 - Why you are pro-life and why this is so important to you and the state.
 - Why the Hyde Amendment is important to pass.
 - Why FOCA is dangerous and why Senator Landrieu should oppose it
 - Why what you are asking for is important, and what would be the negative results for our society if the Senator did not heed your request.
