Christians throughout New Orleans are uniting in the 40 Days for Life New Orleans campaign from September 22 through October 31. Last year, New at least twelve lives were saved from abortion during those days. Now, on September 22rd, we will unite with more than 200 cities in 45 American states, 5 Canadian provinces and the country of Denmark to launch the 2010 40 Days for Life campaign.

In addition to churches and people uniting in 40 days of prayer and fasting for an end to abortion throughout our city, we are participating in a peaceful, prayerful, and legal vigil outside of Louisiana's largest abortion facility in Metairie on Ridgelake Avenue. In the back of church, we invite you to sign up and volunteer to be present in vigil for one or more hours during the 40 days, and help to spread the word to others about this important life-saving effort.
