1. Health Care Rights of Conscience Protection

HB 517: Authored by Representative LeBas
Vote on Concurrence; LARTL Supported

Protects certain health care rights of conscience for all health care professionals in the public and private sectors by granting the right to object from certain services.

Signed by the Governor.

Yea: 88 (+) Nays: 12 (-) Absent: 4 (a)

2. Human-Animal Hybrid Ban

SB 115: Authored by Senator Martiny
Vote on Final Passage; LARTL Supported
Bans the creation of human-animal hybrid embryos. Signed by the Governor.

Yea: 91 (+) Nays: 0 (-) Absent: 13 (a)

3. Choose Life License Plate Restructuring

SB 289: Authored by Senator Appel
Vote on Final Passage; LARTL Supported
Improves the Louisiana Choose License Plate program. Signed by the Governor.

Yea: 85 (+) Nays: 4 (-) Absent: 15 (a)
